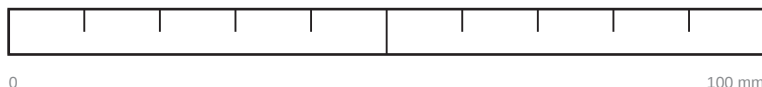

One sheet that exercises color, black, sharpness and alignment. Print at 100% scale.

Scale check: this bar is exactly 100 mm long



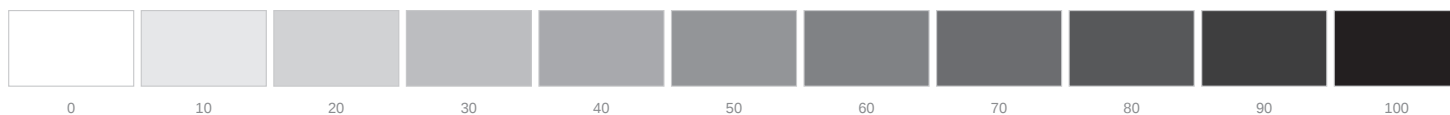
Shorter than your ruler says? The print dialog is scaling the page. Set it to 100%.



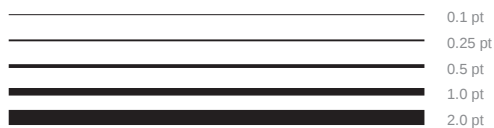
Color bars: CMYK inks and their overprints



Grayscale ramp: 0 to 100% black in 10% steps



Line weights and text sharpness



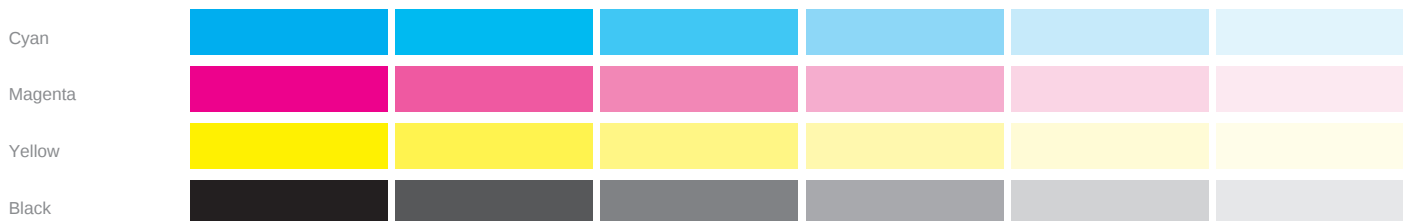
Crisp edges at 5 pt, no fringes or shadows

Crisp edges at 7 pt, no fringes or shadows

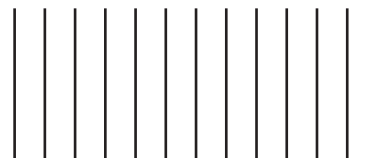
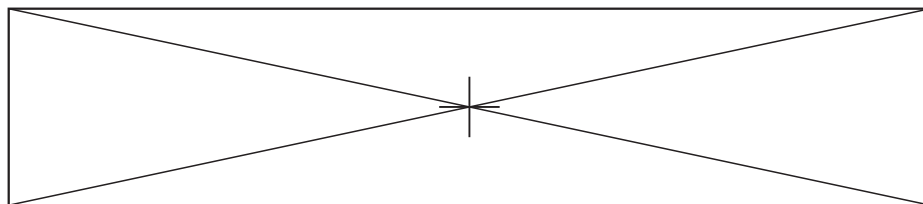
Crisp edges at 9 pt, no fringes or shadows

Crisp edges at 12 pt, no fringes or shadows

Per-channel tint strips: gaps or streaks mean blocked nozzles



Alignment and skew



Even bars: no bidirectional misalignment

After it prints, check three things:

- the 100 mm bar measures 100 mm against a real ruler,
- every color bar and tint strip is present, with no gaps or streaks,
- the grayscale steps are distinct and the diagonals are straight.
